Dear Judge Postma:

Enclosed are the CD of the Hearing June 9, 2011 and the Ruling June 17, 2001 in *Obermeyer vs. Alaska Judicial Council* Case No. 11-1-CD. I would like your file to be complete. I do not know if you can use the information in upcoming proceedings but I hope so. I apologize that I only listened to my part at the beginning as the Complainant.

To summarize, three major issues that were not addressed in the ruling that I stated on June 9 at 1:00 P.M. follow:

1. Everyone involved has a conflict of interest as regards "my good name." I brought up Wev Shea who supposedly has been suspended from the practice of law for 25 months over a conflict of interest. Then, he wrote a rude email that he was not interested in *Obermeyer vs. Alaska Judicial Council*. I explained my relationships with Attorney General John Burns, Ms. Julia Bockman, Mr. Dave Jones, Mr. Larry Cohn, and Mr. Andy Harrington.
2. I talked about the fact that Mr. Larry Cohn has tried to make all of us believe that he got bills after the November, 2010 General Election which I stated I do not believe was true. As someone who has run for political office many times, I know that the local media will not place any ad unless it is paid for in advance.
3. I had written an email to Vic Fischer and Jane Angvik the day before the hearing asking them to join us at the Hearing. Neither did. I was told by Mr. Jerry Anderson, Assistant Executive Director, APOC, that he passed out the email that I had written to Vic and Jane about the APOC Hearing prior to my comments. I told APOC that I absolutely believe that what Vic Fischer did by going on the radio against you several days before the Election in the Third Judicial District was the single factor that resulted in you losing the Retention Election. I stated that I think that someone like Vic Fischer should have had at a minimum to file with the APOC that he was going to be on the ads.

Of course, none of my three major points were addressed in the Ruling. I am very sorry that I think the entire matter was another “kangaroo court.” APOC is kidding themselves by writing that what was done to you was not the dirtiest of partisan politics. I am very sorry that APOC is extremely weak.

I hope that you are pursuing *Kruse et al. v. Fenumiai, et al.*, 3AN-10-11796 CI; *Postma v. State of Alaska Court System, et al.*, 3:10-CV-0249-HRH; and *In the Matter of Richard W. Postma*, Case No. S-14124, ACJC No. 2010-005.
