Please review the file “Manipulation of Anchorage Mayoral Election Results Part I/AIDEA Part II” our web site: tobermeyer.info My allegations were presented to Mr. Timothy Burgess, U.S. Attorney, on April 8 regarding both the Mayoral and Anchorage School Board Races. As an American, I have grave questions about the timely “money flow” as regards Alaska Club allocations owned by Mr. Andy Eker and Mr. Tom Behan through Alaska Industrial Development and Export Authority (AIDEA) under Commissioner Debby Sedwick, Alaska Department of Community & Economic Development. Commissioner Sedwick’s husband is John Sedwick, U.S. District Court Judge, District of Alaska, Anchorage. I ran for Anchorage School Board in the Municipal Election April 2, 2002 and had also run for Mayor April 4, 2000. The documents about “Manipulation of Anchorage Mayoral Election Results 2000” have been on our website for over a year since I have been unable to get anyone in authority to investigate. Please review the fact that Mr. Eker obtained \$13,300,000 on April 26, 2000 as his wife, Mary Hughes, was Municipal Attorney, 1994-July, 2000. My husband, Thomas Obermeyer, Attorney, licensed by similar Missouri Bar Exam in 1990, has worked at Municipal Attorney’s Office since January, 1994. I received 1.9% of the vote in the Mayoral Election which is impossible because of my high visibility and name recognition. I made a joke out of it:”Couldn’t Andy have had enough brains to give me 20%?” Of course, that is the percent I just received in Anchorage School Board Race on April 2, 2002. Mr. Bill Greene was hired by Ms. Hughes as her first assistant in 1994 and replaced her as Municipal Attorney.

The day before the filing deadline for Anchorage School Board on February 7, 2002, I was at AIDEA/AEA Board Meeting and watched Andy Eker refinance 6 loans for a total of \$12,990,816. I dropped the documents off to Mr. John Steiner, Assistant Attorney General, State of Alaska, the next day. He filed against me that afternoon. Then, on April 11, 2002 Alaska Club obtained another 4 refinance issues for \$10,377,285 from AIDEA. All I can do is discuss these issue at AIDEA/AEA Board Meetings and give those in authority the documents. I gave copies to 11 member Anchorage Assembly on April 12 and several Alaska Legislators on April 13.

I consider it demented that I had to run against not one, but two, licensed Alaska attorneys for School Board as my husband, Tom Obermeyer, Attorney, has been denied reciprocity here for 12 years and is still not licensed to practice law in Alaska. For the reader’s information, Mr. Jeff Friedman, the other licensed Alaska attorney in the School Board race, grew up in Rochester, New York where In the Matter of the Application of Thomas S. Obermeyer, American Law Reports 4th Volume 57 1195 (1986) on our website at the top, was published. I am convinced that Mr. Friedman moved to Alaska because of this case which is the stock and trade of every lawyer and judge in our great nation. Tom has faithfully and resolutely written 27 essay tests for 81 days of his life, has attempted twice to be heard in U.S. Supreme Court in No. 00-1176 on our website, and has not been licensed to practice law in Alaska over an 18 year period. Alaska is the only state in the United States that does not have a law school. The two licensed Alaska attorneys will be in a Run-Off on May 7.

Please come to the AIDEA/AEA Meetings and raise questions to those in authority about fair elections.
