Dear Ms. Obermyer:

On May 28, 2003 at approximately 2:30 pm you came uninvited to the reception area of the Anchorage office of Alaska Legal Services Corporation (ALSC) and demanded to see an employee about a matter not related to the employee's work or ALSC. When the receptionist informed you that you must make an appointment in advance to see the employee you threw your eyeglasses and struck the receptionist. You also raised your voice and spoke to the receptionist in a threatening manner. The supervising attorneys then instructed you to leave but you refused until the police were called. You left ALSC before the police arrived.

Given the above, and the fact that we are obligated to provide our employees and clients with a safe environment, we are informing you that you are no longer welcome in the Anchorage office of ALSC. Should you again come uninvited to Alaska Legal Services Corporation, 1016 W. 6th Avenue, Suite 200, Anchorage, Alaska 99501 we will immediately notify the police and have a complaint made against you for trespass. Should you ever become income eligible for our free legal services, an over the phone intake can be conducted.

You are hereby advised that you may appeal this notice to the Board of Directors of ALSC by sending a written request to Andy Harrington, Executive Director, ALSC, 1648 Cushman St. #300, Fairbanks, Alaska 99701-6206. However, this notice remains in effect during the pendency of an appeal should you decide to file one. Your written request must describe the grounds for your appeal.

Dear Dr. Obermeyer:

This letter refers to your grievance against attorney James K. Metcalf received January 21, 2003.

Under Alaska Bar Rule 22(a), grievances against attorneys must be in writing, signed by the complainant, and contain a clear statement of details of each act of alleged misconduct, including the time and place of each. The grievance must contain allegations which, if true, would constitute grounds for attorney discipline.

As you know, I sent a copy of your grievance to the attorney shortly after you submitted it. I have now received a response from the attorney (copy enclosed) and, after a careful review of the materials which you and the attorney have submitted, I have determined that the attorney has satisfactorily addressed the allegations contained in your grievance. As a result, there is an inadequate or insufficient basis for opening an investigation.
