
Thank you for attending the Commonwealth North Board meeting on July 22, 2003 and making your presentation.

Dear Judge Hunt, Mr. Colbert, Attorney, Co-Chairs, and Members of Constitutional Convention Committee Commonwealth North do Mr. Duane Heyman:

Please review web site: www.tobermeyer.info. As a member of Commonwealth North since its formation about 1980, I requested to join the University of Alaska Study Group when it was organizing in Spring, 2002 which was not forthcoming. Theresa Nangle Obermeyer vs. University of Alaska #A81-448 No. 85-3826 DC CV "Not for Publication" was filed October 28, 1981 over the outrageous manner four other professional employees and I were treated when we were all locked out of our offices here in June, 1979. I had worked at three other colleges prior to coming to my position at University of Alaska. My vita is on our web site. My husband, Thomas S. Obermeyer, Attorney, first interfaced with Anchorage U.S. District Court over Thomas S. Obermeyer vs. Alaska USA Federal Credit Union #A84-0009 CV which was his lawsuit regarding the unfair election of Board of Directors Alaska USA Federal Credit Union. Tom ran for the Board of Directors Alaska USA because he obtained a student loan from about the second largest federal credit union in United States for law school and he simply wanted to show his appreciation.

After Tom was failed on three Alaska Bar Exams, he was advised by many licensed attorneys here to sue Alaska Bar Association which he did. The result was his lead case in the summary of American law, In the Matter of the Application of Thomas S. Obermeyer 717 Pacific Reporter 2d 382, 57 American Law Reports 4th 1195 (Alaska April 18, 1986). It was only in 1993 that my husband was informed by Mr. Brant McGee, Attorney, that Application of Theodore F. Stevens 355 Pacific Reporter 2d 164 (Alaska August 8, 1960) existed which inextricably linked my husband to Ted Stevens. The first sentence of Mr. Stevens' case states that he was admitted to practice law in Alaska by reciprocity but vacant in the entire case is the state from which this now 34 year incumbent U.S. Senator had to be licensed in order to apply for reciprocity. We are certain that the 34 year incumbent U.S. Senator I am again running against was not admitted to practice law in any other state when he was licensed here by reciprocity. I allege that this is criminal fraud. On May 8, 1986, three weeks after my husband's lead case was published, my pending civil lawsuit against University of Alaska was ruled on by U.S. Court of Appeals for Ninth Circuit in a "Not for Publication" decision that is not worth the paper it is written on requiring me to pay \$17,161.75. We only connected Tom's ALR 4th citation with my, federal lawsuit against University of Alaska in 1994. I do not believe anything has changed since I was employed at University of Alaska 1978-79. In fact, I observe more retired American military generals' employment and foreign students' matriculation locally.

As you must know, I have also been assaulted and jailed twice in Anchorage Federal Building on June 29, 1994 and August 16, 1995 and have weathered three fabricated non-jury federal criminal trials United States of America vs. Theresa Nangle Obermeyer DC #A94-0074, #A95-0082 CR, and #A96-0231 CR. My husband, Thomas S. Obermeyer, Attorney, over 18 1/2 years has been denied Alaska law license even though he has taken 27 Alaska Bar Exams for 81 days after studying for months each time and was licensed by similar Missouri Bar Exam in 1990, a state with which Alaska has reciprocity. Tom should have been admitted to practice law here in 1990 by reciprocity. I now have two other "Not for Publication" rulings by U.S. Court of Appeals for Ninth Circuit including No. 94-30368 DC #A94-0074 CR WBE filed August 23, 1995 and No. 96-30185 DC#A94-0074 CR WBE filed March 27, 1997 and four rejections from U.S. Supreme Court in Theresa Nangle Obermeyer vs. United States of America No. 95-6843 and No. 96-9486. My husband has been rejected twice from U.S. Supreme Court in Thomas S. Obermeyer Attorney vs. Alaska Bar Association No. 00-1176. The rejection letters are on our web site. I was acquitted November 10, 1998 in State of Alaska/Hilton Anchorage vs. Theresa Nangle Obermeyer 3AN-S98-2211 CR in a 7 day my only jury trial but was unable to file a civil lawsuit for damages. Municipal Board of Ethics held six "kangaroo courts" against me in Spring, 1993, three State of Alaska Department of Public Safety Violent Crimes Compensation Board hearings March 6, 1995 #95-069, March 13, 1996 #96-077, and January 26, 1999 #98-365 were held, and I was harassed in Bob Christal vs. Theresa Nangle Obermeyer 3AN-99-12271 CI for about a year and a half. In light of the foregoing, I believe I can speak to the corruption and lack of leadership of U.S. District Court, District of Alaska, Anchorage very well, not to mention our State of Alaska courts.

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Therefore, I was fascinated this summer when I was invited to join the Constitutional Convention Committee Commonwealth North as I am running for U.S. Senate for the second time. In 1996 after I was jailed for 29 days, I became the Democratic nominee to U.S. Senate but got no help from anyone in this nation. Thomas S. Obermeyer, Attorney and Theresa Nangle Obermeyer vs. United States of America U.S Department of Justice and Federal Bureau of Prisons A00-0033 CV was filed over my incarceration. My treatment because I filed for U.S. Senate on May 28, 1996 was ruled appropriate by Judge Holland.

In Summer, 2001 I watched the now 34 year incumbent U.S. Senator who is distributing the U.S. Treasury to buy Alaskans' votes use his power to get his son, Ben, appointed to Alaska State Senate. Our web site file "Frank and Lisa Murkowski, Ben Stevens" has the wording of January 16, 2002 veto override that Frank Murkowski got through Alaska Legislature as he was running for Governor. If he is elected, he will be allowed to appoint his successor, Lisa Murkowski, within five days of taking his oath of office. Will Ted Stevens appoint his son, Ben, as well? Congressman Don Young's son-in-law, Art Nelson, is currently running for Alaska State House against incumbent Honorable Harry Crawford. Our courts are an abysmal failure for their lack of leadership in letting Ted Stevens, Frank Murkowski, and Don Young misuse their power to position their family members in public office at the same time my husband is still not licensed to practice law in Alaska.

At our Constitutional Convention Meeting on August 2 I was unable to get a second as follows:

"Shall there be a constitutional convention?... NO... Weak elected leadership and judicial inaction cannot be fixed by a constitutional convention..."

Please let me know if you can still incorporate that terminology or similar wording in the document the Constitutional Convention Committee will submit to Board of Directors. If the failure of Alaska Bench and Bar to address the issues my husband and I have been raising for two and a half decades cannot be included in the document, I do not see any reason for me to continue on this committee.

I find it ironic, Judge Hunt, that you are at Judicial College in Reno, Nevada this week to teach American law to Bulgarian judges when if our circumstances are any indication, there is not a "rule of law" in Alaska. I live in the only state in United States that does not have a law school. Several territories of our great nation have law schools. If you, several members of the Constitutional Convention Committee who are members of Alaska Bench and Bar and led by the weak and unethical life appointed federal judges in Alaska, like to review any of our lawsuits over almost 25 years, please let us know.

Since I am aware that University of Alaska Study Group is meeting weekly, please forward this correspondence to them with my request to appear before them to explain what I know about University of Alaska. It is time for American legal education in Alaska.

Lastly, I will appear on Cable Television Channel 9 Fil-Am Showtime tomorrow Wednesday, August 7, 8:00-8:30 P.M. and repeated Sunday, August 11, 9:00-9:30 P.M. I will try to be with you Thursday, August 8, too early at 7:00A.M.
